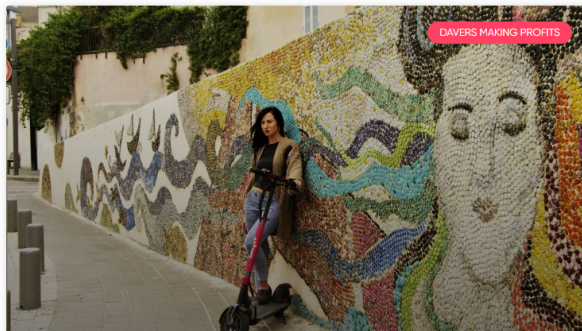

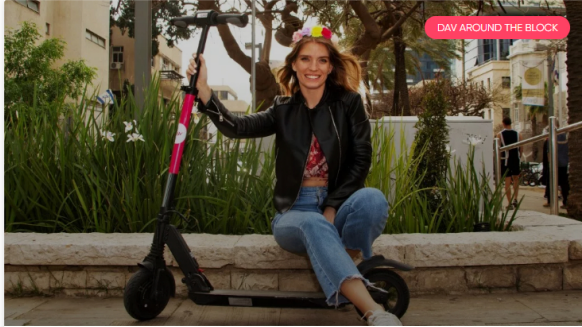

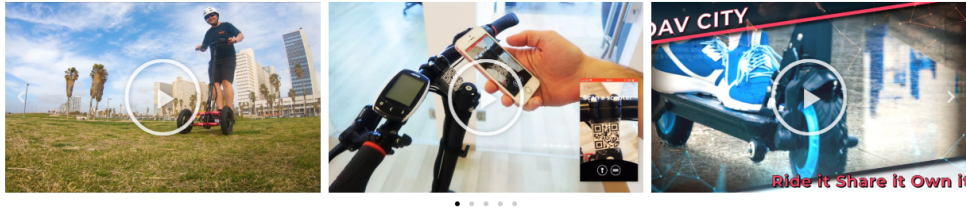


The Transport Sector is Ripe for the Gig Economy
